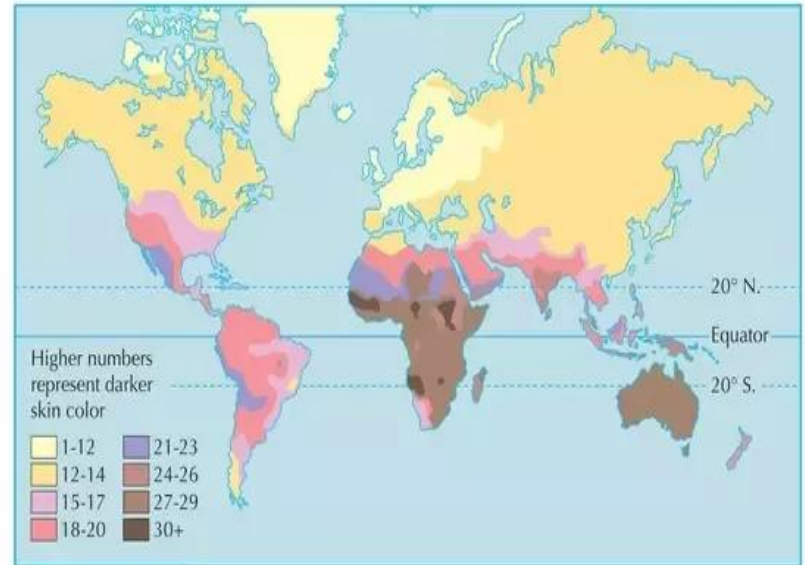
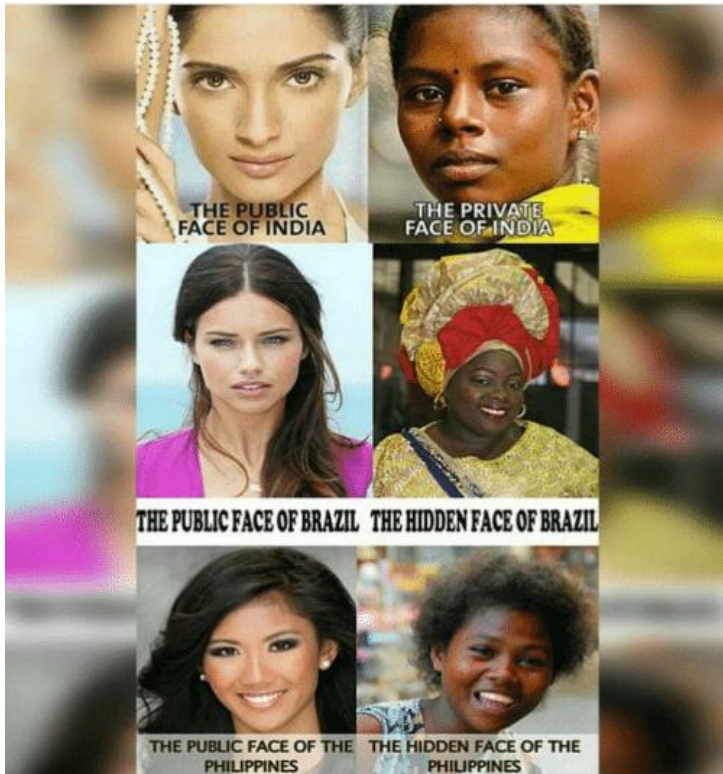


FIGURE 26.13. Variation in human skin color is associated with levels of UV irradiation, which are higher near the equator.

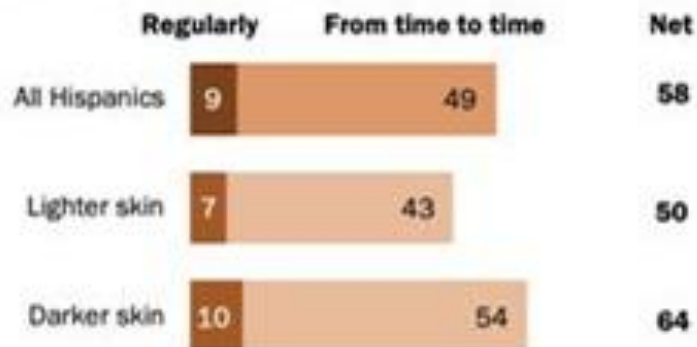

What is Colourism

Colourism is also evident within the native continent of Africa, which many scholars have also identified as a colonial legacy, as it was socially implemented from European settlers in the 19th Century through concepts of racial profiling.

What is Colourism

The Democratic Republic of the Congo and Rwanda, are examples where Europeans used differences in African Ethnicity as an instrument for applying western social constructs of hierarchy Colonial administrators attempted to form order and decentralise the tribes by giving certain power and privileges, to the Tutsis, as they were 'whiter' than the Hutus

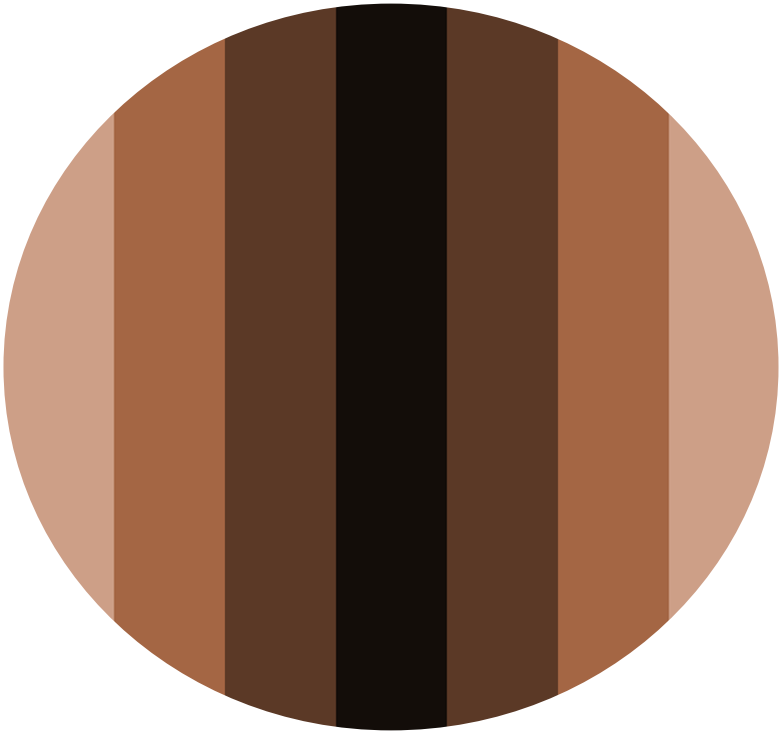
What is Colourism

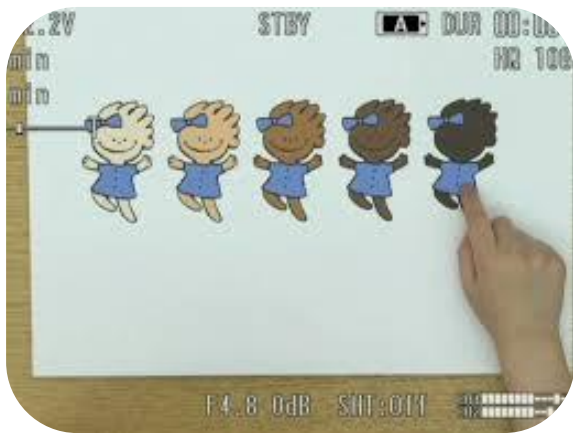

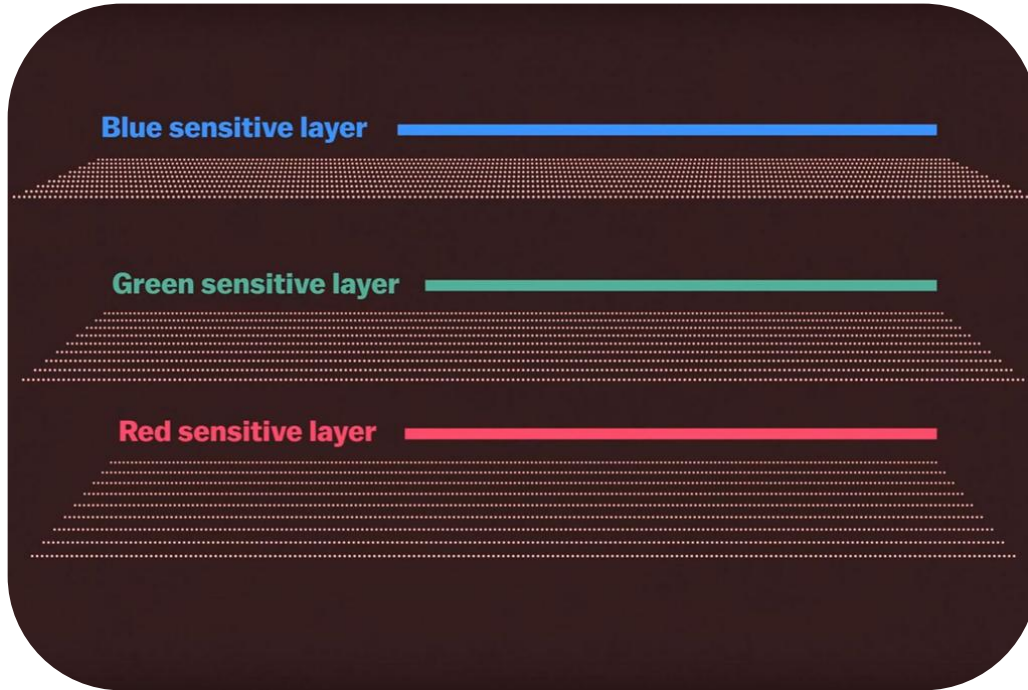
