Nationalism


How a particular group of people **IDENTIFY** themselves with their country.

Israel's journey from slavery to citizenship

Read Exodus: The book of exodus introduces us to a people who having inherited the promises of nationhood from their forefathers but are living in the bondage of a foreign ruling house. Although they have multiplied in Egypt the lack of their own authority, law and government has left them subject to the principality ruling over them.

Response to authority

Hebrews 12:18-21

- Christ is our mediator.
- Christ is our King.
- Sinai differs from Zion.
- The absence of authority creates a void for idolatry (false authorities).



Response to law

Exodus 32:17 -18 / John 14:15

- The law is the will of the authority.
- We must value what makes us distinct from other nations.
- Knowledge and obedience to the will of the authority brings stature and mastery.






Response to government & citizenship

Exodus 32:26-28 / Matthew 10:35

- Allegiance to the Lord.
- Assemble and be ready to act on command.
- Arm yourself with an understanding of the kingdom.
- Hold to the standard of the word of God.
- Hold fellow citizens to account.
- Recognize the danger of disqualification from the status of citizenship.
